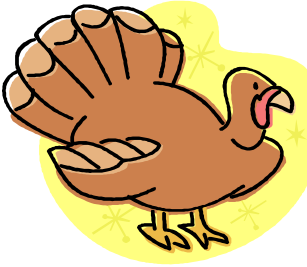


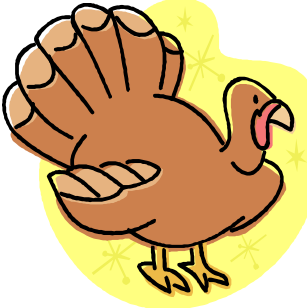

November 2023



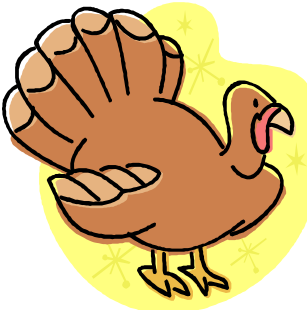
Pre-registration for the following programs and activities is now underway. Please be sure to sign up in advance as seating is limited.

This is a leisurely paced approximately 4 hour excursion. Wear sturdy shoes/hiking boots and bring a snack/lunch and water. We'll meet at 10:00 a.m. at the Edison Monument on Edison Road, Sparta. The Library will be closed on **Election Day**, Tuesday, November 7th. Please remember to vote!

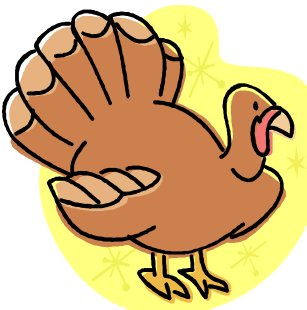

The Friends of the Library Executive Board will meet Tuesday, November 14th, at 1:30 p.m.

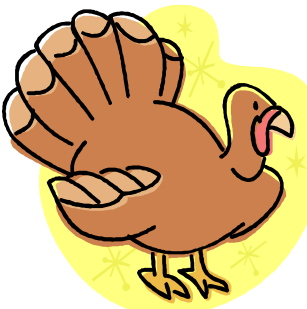
